



## **Golf Program**

At the beginning of 2023, Pro Kids transitioned to age-based programming for our golf classes. This shift allowed for members who are of similar age to participate in class together, while allowing the Golf Professionals to focus on delivering age-appropriate content to our members. These classes consist of teaching golf skills, rules, etiquette, life skills, and our First Tee Core Values. This also allowed coaches to improve our programming, by implementing appropriate long term athletic development specific to the age of our students.

We also increased our programming hours and classes, this led to an increase in flexibility and accessibility to Pro Kids members and their families. By doing so, we increased participation in the program 25% compared to 2022.

This year, Pro Kids had numerous success stories both on and off the course. Pro Kids had four participants who were selected to national First Tee events. These members represented Pro Kids in events such as The First Tee Leadership Academy, Game Changers Academy, First Tee Innovators Forum and the PURE Insurance Championship at Pebble Beach. These members were selected by First Tee National after completing both an application and interview process.

## **Learning Center**

#### WHAT'S GOING ON IN CITY HEIGHTS?

We are excited to announce that we achieved many of our goals this year, which include increasing community outreach in City Heights. This year, we have welcomed 192 new members to the Pro Kids family. Currently, we have 474 students attending our facility in City Heights, with 429 students receiving financial aid.

The Pro Kids Learning Center is a safe and welcoming environment for students to receive homework assistance, socialize with friends, and participate in fun activities after school. We offered various field trips and workshops to enhance the learning experience and retain students. We provided numerous workshops for all ages, including cooking, financial literacy, and exercise classes. Additionally, we offered over 50 incredible field trips, such as indoor skydiving, rock climbing, paddle boarding, and visits to all the Balboa Park museums.

We are excited to share that we have partnered with local schools in City Heights to cater to the high demand for our learning center. We have set up a program that enables elementary school students to attend the Pro Kids Academy twice a week, freeing up space for new students to join the program.

Our older students were privileged to attend career panels in our facility and visit various colleges, including UCLA, SDSU, USD, and UCSB.

### WHAT'S GOING ON IN OCEANSIDE?

Pro Kids Oceanside celebrated its 10th anniversary!

Oceanside has gained more than 100 new members in the last year. A major factor in our retention success is our after school pick up program. We shuttle from two middle schools. Since the closure of Reynolds Elementary School, we now pick up from Foussat Elementary School, helping us maintain a thriving elementary school program.

This year we offered onsite guest speakers for the first time since COVID, bringing in speakers to teach our members about a variety of topics from veterinary work, small business ownership, archeology, and more! We also strive to get the kids out into the community by taking them on field trips to local business, museums, farms, educational centers and college campuses. This coming year we will be offering monthly opportunities to explore and learn more about our community.

Our members are exhibiting the Pro Kids Core Values and we couldn't be more excited to watch them grow and thrive. A handful of middle school girls joined their afterschool leadership program, choosing to attend weekly meetings on campus. We couldn't be prouder of their initiative and dedication to expanding their knowledge base.

## Funding & Revenue Summary

**FUNDING & REVENUE** 

Pro Kids received over **\$2.64 million** in grants, donations and fundraising events.

In addition, Pro Kids received over **\$622k** through membership and course revenue.

**Fun fact:** Colina Park Golf Course has served over 35,000 rounds of golf. Since 1994, Colina Park Golf Course has served as the headquarters for Pro Kids, First Tee - San Diego. 100% of all golf course revenue goes towards supporting Pro Kids.

### Celebrates Gala

Our Celebrates Gala, the largest fundraising event for Pro Kids, took place in June at the Hilton La Jolla Torrey Pines and it successfully raised over \$600,000. ### Pro Kids Golf Invitational
