This year's completion of our five-year Strategic Plan marks a pivotal moment for Pro Kids, setting the course for our future growth and deepening our impact. More than just a roadmap, it is a shared commitment to expanding opportunities for young people across City Heights and Oceanside. I have already seen this vision come to life through the dedication of our team—creating safe, supportive spaces where young people not only develop their golf skills but also grow as leaders in their communities.



The impact of Pro Kids is evident in every milestone achieved. Whether it is a young member stepping onto the golf course for the first time, a high school senior securing a scholarship, or an alum returning to mentor the next generation, our work is creating lasting change. In 2024, Pro Kids provided over 5,000 hours of structured programming to 767 members, offering golf instruction, STEM workshops, field trips, and academic support. Many of our members are first-generation college students, gaining valuable skills and mentorship to support their educational journeys. To ensure that financial barriers never stand in the way of opportunity, we provided \$515,000 in financial assistance to member families. This impact is made possible by the generosity of our supporters, with donor retention remaining a key factor in sustaining and expanding our programs.

As we look ahead, our focus remains on expanding access, strengthening our programs, and fostering lifelong connections within the Pro Kids family. Your partnership makes this possible. Board of Directors President's Message

2024 has been another very successful and productive year for Pro Kids, First Tee - San Diego. We are pleased that Jennifer Pillsbury, our new CEO, began her leadership in January, 2024! In addition, we just completed our five-year Strategic Plan defining our plans and goals for our Board and Staff to execute. This is a very exciting time for us.

We continue to serve 767 kids in both of our locations, City Heights and Oceanside providing character training and development, educational programming and teaching golf skills to our members. The safe, drug free and like home environment has provided these kids a secure place where they can develop their lives.



Again this year, 46 kids have secured a Pro Kids scholarships to both technical and university level schools. This year, we have provided \$169k in scholarships for the kids. Some of these kids return as volunteers to Pro Kids during their school breaks to assist our 35 staff in providing our services.

Our two major fundraisers, Celebrates and Pro Kids Golf Invitational were again very successful in funding our programs. In addition, our other major donors and our ability to receive grants supplement our funding requirements. Of course, we could not provide our services without significant support from our individual donors!! Thanks to all who provide the resources for us to have an impact on these kids. 

ABOUT PRO KIDS, FIRST TEE - SAN DIEGO

The mission of Pro Kids, First Tee - San Diego is to challenge underserved youth to excel in life by promoting character development, life skills, and values through education and the game of golf. Our team of dedicated staff is devoted to our youth participants and work to provide meaningful experiences, lessons, and connections both on and off the course.



Golf Program

This year, Pro Kids focused on increasing accessibility for youth, ensuring that no child is excluded due to cost. We expanded class times and opportunities, making our facility more accessible to eager young golfers. Our golf team, with over 50 years of combined experience, developed a curriculum that integrates golf skills, life skills, and etiquette. Through an age-based model, we provide tailored lessons that evolve from activity-based learning to a mastery-driven approach as players progress.

A key highlight was the revamping of our certification system with a seven-level structure, offering transparency and long-term goals. Additionally, our new PRO Kids Points System encourages participation in community service, practice, and workshops, allowing members to earn rewards like equipment or exclusive opportunities.








Van Pick Up at Partner Schools Field Trips Throughout San Diego Conducted Workshops and Clubs

At both Pro Kids locations, we provide transportation for members from two elementary schools, three middle schools, and two high schools, ensuring that students can access our programs safely and consistently. Beyond golf, we've organized over 65 enriching field trips to museums, hiking trails, beaches, and more, exposing members to new experiences and ideas. We've also conducted over 75 hands-on workshops, including STEM projects, cooking classes, chess clubs, and cultural nights, fostering personal growth and a strong sense of community.

Pro Kids is proud to serve multiple generations of families, with retention being a key part of our success. It's inspiring to see younger siblings eagerly waiting to join, with some starting as early as age 7 and staying involved throughout their childhood.

At our Oceanside location, the Girls Mentoring Club has exceeded expectations. Of the 10 freshman girls who transitioned to high school this year, eight joined their school's golf team, with most earning spots on junior varsity.

In City Heights, our outreach efforts have grown significantly. The Program Director successfully organized 24 golf clinics at local schools during physical education classes and after-school programs. These efforts have expanded our reach to include new institutions such as Crawford High School, Euclid Elementary, Edison Elementary, Cherokee Point Elementary, Fay Elementary, and Hoover High School.





Scholarship Program

At Pro Kids, we believe that education is one of the most powerful tools to transform lives. Through our Scholarship Program, we are committed to guiding our members on their journey to higher education and future success. From college road trips to scholarship opportunities, this year has been one of growth, new milestones, and unwavering support for our students as they strive to achieve their dreams.
